SERVICE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE EXCESS GARBAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE

Parma Heights – Beginning Saturday June 9, 2012, Parma Heights will institute a Saturday Refuse Drop Off. Under the program, residents will be able to drop off their excess household refuse at the Parma Heights Service Garage on the second and fourth Saturdays of every month between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., according to Michelle Teresi, Building, Housing and Recycling Coordinator.

The free Saturday Refuse Drop Off program will be offered through the month of October at the garage located at 6184 Pearl Road in the Greenbrier Commons. Depending upon need, the program will restart again in the spring of 2013. Proof of residency is required.

The Saturday Refuse Drop Off program will provide community members with a convenient resource to dispose of garbage items that are either too large, or in an excessive amount, to be placed in the automated collection bins. “Residents are asked to please limit drop-offs to regular household garbage only and no construction material or tires,” said Teresi. Hazardous waste items will not be accepted during these regular Saturday drop-off times. “Specific dates and times are announced for hazardous waste collection,” Teresi explained.
