

NOPEC INFORMATION

We are members of NOPEC, a council of governments that aggregately purchases electric and gas for its members.

The NOPEC gas supplier is NEXtera.

NOPEC recently negotiated a new 8 month contract with NEXtera to also provide us with electricity at a discounted rate of 6% for residential homes and 4% for small businesses.

This week, residents and businesses will be mailed opt-out cards if they wish to opt out of the NOPEC pricing and seek a different rate on the open market.

The best place to compare prices is on the PUCO website where they can do an “Apples-to-Apples” comparison:

There is zero cancellation or no early termination fees to residents who wish to opt-out of NOPEC.

To continue receiving the NOPEC negotiated rate, residents are not required to do anything. Residents need not to anything to continue receiving the NOPEC negotiated rate, however please note that there are two (2) options available to NOPEC members:

Option 1: The NOPEC contract provides for a fixed rate of \$0.04978 per kWh from the January, 2017 until the June, 2017 meter read dates. The price on the remaining two months of the contract can change. NOPEC will publish this information on their website 30 days prior to the effective date. To continue receiving this NOPEC negotiated rate, residents are not required to do anything.

Option 2: Residents in this plan can choose a variable monthly rate that will always be 6% less than the Utility’s Price to Compare (standard rate) for the term of the agreement. *Note: enrollment in this option is limited and subject to availability.* To enroll, you must call 1.855.667.3201
