

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-12

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 171, MORAL CLAIMS COMMISSION,  
OF THE PARMA HEIGHTS CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, an Ad-Hoc Committee of the Parma Heights City Council was appointed and convened to review procedures for processing moral claims submitted to the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Ad Hoc Committee met to review these procedures; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the information received by the Ad-Hoc Committee a recommendation was made to the Parma Heights City Council to repeal Chapter 171 of the Codified Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, the Parma Heights City Council desires to repeal Chapter 171, Moral Claims Commission.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. Chapter 171 Moral Claims Commission of the Codified Ordinances as it has heretofore existed is repealed effective immediately.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of said City and for the further reason it is necessary to repeal Chapter 171 Moral Claims Commission; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
