

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-15

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A NINETY (90) DAY MORATORIUM FOR THE INSTALLATION, ERECTION OR PLACEMENT OF DONATION/RECYCLING BINS WITHIN THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a Donation Bin is defined as any box, building, trailer or other receptacle that is intended for use as a collection point for donated clothing or other household materials at times when no employee or representative of the sponsoring company or organization is present to accept donations; and

WHEREAS, a Recycling Bin is defined as any box, building, trailer or other receptacle that is intended for use as a collection point for recyclable materials, including but not limited to, glass, paper, aluminum or plastics.

WHEREAS, Council is reviewing the establishment of rules, regulations and or Ordinances for Donation/Recycling Bins.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. There is imposed a ninety (90) day moratorium of the installation, erection or placement of Donation/Recycle Bins within the City of Parma Heights.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary to impose a moratorium to further review the rules, regulations and/or Ordinances for Donation/Recycle Bins; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
