

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF PARMA AND WITH ALLIED CORPORATION, THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT CONCRETE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service determined that it is necessary to purchase asphalt material for the repair and maintenance of the streets in the City, and;

WHEREAS, the Council passed Ordinance 2015-1 authorizing the Director of Public Service to competitively bid for asphalt material, and;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the passage of Ordinance 2015-1 the Director of Public Service determined that it was in the best interest of the City to partner with the City of Parma in the bidding and purchase of asphalt material, and;

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2015 the Council in the City of Parma authorized its Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the City of Parma Heights and Allied Corporation, the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of asphalt concrete.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with the City of Parma and Allied Corporation, the lowest and best bidder, for the purchase of asphalt concrete, substantially in the form as is attached hereto as Exhibit A and approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2. Council finds and determines that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to purchase the material for the upcoming 2015 paving season; wherefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval of the Mayor.


