

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-27

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF EXHIBIT "E" TO ORDINANCE NO. 2013-8; TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATION FOR THE CIVILIAN CLERICAL EMPLOYEES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, compensation for non-aligned employees of the City of Parma Heights is governed by Payroll Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council to modify the payroll brackets by providing compensation for Civilian Clerical Employees in the Police Department of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That effective August 13, 2015 Section 1 of Exhibit E to Ordinance No. 2013-8 shall be amended to read in pertinent part as follows:

<u>Classification</u>	<u>Effective Date</u>	<u>Compensation</u>
Civilian Clerk/ Case Manager (Full Time)	8/13/15	\$30,000/yr - \$43,000/yr
Civilian Clerk/ Case Manager (Part-Time)	8/13/15	\$14.00/hr - \$21.00/hr
Civilian Clerk/ Receptionist (Part-Time)	8/13/15	\$ 13.00/hr - \$16.80/hr

Section 2. That the compensation reflected in Section1, above, and any overtime compensation, if and when necessary, shall be based on regular work period of forty (40) hours per week and two thousand and eighty (2,080) hours per year.

Section 2. That all other Exhibits and sub-sections thereof found in Ordinance No. 2013-8, accepting the item specifically noted above shall remain intact and unchanged.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of said

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of said City and for the further reason it is necessary to establish compensation for Civilian Clerks in the Police Department of the City of Parma Heights; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
