

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 36

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR DELINQUENT DEBT COLLECTION SERVICES WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights (“the City”) entered into an Agreement (“Agreement”) with Great Lakes Billing pursuant to §153.12 of the Codified Ordinances; to provide third party ambulance billing services on behalf of the City of Parma Heights; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights desires to use the services of the Ohio Attorney General to collect debt owed the City for ambulance billings;

WHEREAS, the City is required to enter into a Delinquent Debt Collection Agreement with the Ohio Attorney General.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. In accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Parma Heights, the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement between the City of Parma Heights and the Ohio Attorney General in the form as identified as Exhibit “A” attached hereto, and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary for the City to enter into a Delinquent Debt Collection Agreement to engage the Ohio Attorney General to undertake the collection of delinquent debt owed to the City; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
