

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 55

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15 OF ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-50; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, In order to properly reflect operational needs during the 2015 budget year and to conclude 2015 financial operations of the City of Parma Heights in an orderly fashion, the amendment of Section 15 of Annual Appropriations Ordinance No. 2015-50 is deemed to be necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 15 of Ordinance 2015-50 (Annual Appropriations Ordinance) is amended to read, as follows:

That there be appropriated from the DEPOSIT TRUST FUND the following:


Advance-Out	\$	0
Building Department Refund	\$	4,500
Temporary Deposits Refunds	\$	1,350,000
Planning, Zoning Refunds	\$	0
Other Expense	\$	0
TOTAL DEPOSIT TRUST FUND	\$	1,354,500

SECTION 2. That all other sections of Ordinance 2015-50 (Annual Appropriations Ordinance) shall remain unchanged, and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4 This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary that said ordinance is required to be enacted and effective as soon as possible to facilitate an appropriate conclusion to the financial operations of the City for the year 2015; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
