**AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW CHAPTER 1321 BUILDING FEES, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Director of Public and the Building Official desire to codified a list for all building fees.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That new Chapter 1321 Building Fees, in the form identified as Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten be adopted effective immediately.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary for the efficient operation of the Building Department, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

CHAPTER 1321
BUILDING FEES

Section 1321.01 Building Fees

Except as otherwise specifically provided for, the following provisions shall prevail in the issuance of all types of permits. The Director of Public Service and/or Building Official, before issuing any permit, are authorized to charge and collect the fees specified in this chapter. The fees prescribed herein shall be additive and, unless otherwise specifically provided, separate fees shall be paid for each of the items listed. All fees shall be computed and determined by the Director of Public Service and/or Building Official, who shall give a receipt for cash payment. Fees for plan examination and/or landscape review shall be separate and paid directly to the Plan Examiner, Alternate Plan Examiner and/or Landscape Architect, who shall give a receipt for cash payment.

Section 1321.07 RE-INSPECTION, PLAN CHANGES AND WORK WITHOUT PERMIT.

A. RE-INSPECTION

A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be charged for each additional re-inspection

made necessary by faulty or incomplete work or inaccurate information on a permit or application for an electrical, heating or plumbing permit.

B. PLAN CHANGES

When major revisions are made after the original permits have been issued, an additional fee of 50% of the original permit shall be collected.

C. WORK WITHOUT PERMIT

The permit(s) cost shall be doubled for work begun or completed without obtaining a permit.

1329.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree and shall be fined not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or imprisoned not more than ninety days, or both. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
