

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-9

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) FORD UTILITY VEHICLE, FOUR (4) FORD SEDANS AND VARIOUS EQUIPMENT VIA A LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH KEY GOVERNMENT FINANCE COMPANY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has listed Statewide Ford as a vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has Ford Sedans listed in state bid pricing; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has Ford Utility Vehicles listed in state bid pricing; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase four (4) Ford Sedans for the total sum of \$135,801.00; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase one (1) Ford Utility Vehicle for the sum of \$41,984.00; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid vehicles are being purchased at the state bid price from the vendor listed on the State Bid; and

WHEREAS, no bidding is required since the vehicles are being purchased at the state bid price; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need to outfit said police vehicles with radio equipment, gun mounts, radio mounts cabinets, Panasonic Tough Book Laptops, computer mounts, power adaptors and graphics and installation of the aforesaid items in the aggregate amount of \$20,842.05 from various vendors as identified as Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the financing of these vehicles and associated equipment described in Exhibit A will be through Key Government Finance Co. via a lease with an option to purchase at the termination of said lease; and

WHEREAS, this Council is also obviating the formal competitive bidding process for the purchase of aforesaid police sedans and equipment package by the Authority granted to it in Article V Section 6 of the Charter, and Sections 145.08 and 145.09 of the Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service has been authorized to purchase from Statewide Ford four (4) 2017 Ford police sedans for the sum of \$135,801.00.

Section 2. The Director of Public service has been authorized to purchase from Statewide ford one (1) Ford Utility Vehicle for the sum of \$41,984.00

Section 3. The Director of Public Service has been authorized to purchase additional law enforcement equipment for said vehicles as specified in Exhibit A in the aggregate amount of \$20,842.05.

Section 4. The financing of the aforesaid four (4) police sedans, one (1) Ford Utility Vehicle and various equipment be via a lease with an option to buy through Key Government Financing for a total amount funded by the lease of \$198,627.05; which total includes the pricing shown in Section 1, Section 2 and Section 3 of this Ordinance.

Section 5. The said lease shall be on terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 6. The Mayor is authorized to execute on behalf of the Municipality a lease purchase agreement with Key Government Financing as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 7. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 8. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary to obtain four (4) police sedans for the Police Department; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
