

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-2

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING AN EXPENDITURE FOR ASPHALT MATERIAL FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE STREETS IN THE CITY, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PARTNER WITH THE CITY OF PARMA IN THE BIDDING AND PURCHASE OF ASPHALT CONCRETE MATERIAL, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A WRITTEN CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council is considering asphalt repair on various streets within the City;
and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service determined that it is necessary to purchase asphalt concrete material for the repair and maintenance of the streets in the City; and,

WHEREAS, as evidenced by Ordinance No. 2015- 20 passed May 26, 2015 the Director of Public Service determined that it was in the best interest of the City in 2015 to partner with the City of Parma in the bidding and purchase of asphalt concrete material; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service once again has determined that the bidding and purchase of asphalt concrete material would be in the best interest of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights, pursuant to section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code, may participate in a contract of another political subdivision; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to partner with the City of Parma in the bidding and purchase of asphalt material and to advertise twice in a newspaper of general circulation with the Municipality and to post such Invitation to Bid on the City of Parma Heights official web page; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Parma Heights has been advised that it is necessary that an expenditure for items as noted in the title, be authorized and directed in accordance with the provisions of Article V Section 6 of the Charter of the City of Parma Heights.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. This Council authorizes and directs the Director of Public Service to partner with the City of Parma in the bidding and purchase of asphalt concrete material.

Section 2. The expenditure of monies of this municipality for items as noted in the title, which expenditure is now estimated to exceed \$25,000.00, and is authorized and directed. Said expenditure shall be made from monies appropriated for such purpose.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a written contract with the

lowest and best bidder after such advertising, said lowest and best bidder to be determined by motion of this Council.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health safety and welfare of the City and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to purchase the material for the upcoming 2017 paving season; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
