

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A SALES AGREEMENT WITH TRY AUTOMOTIVE SALES TO PURCHASE A 2005 INTERNATIONAL DUMP TRUCK FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a real and present emergency has occurred in the Department of Public Service; and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid emergency consists of a seriously deteriorated 2000 International Dump Truck which is out of service; and,

WHEREAS, the 2000 International Dump Truck is not safe to have a plow attached to it due to a cracked frame that was welded four (4) years ago; and,

WHEREAS, the International Dump Truck has a rotted rear bed, rotted tanks and an unsafe airbrake system; and,

WHEREAS, the 2000 International Dump Truck was vital to the City's truck fleet and needs to be replaced immediately to effectively address plowing; and,

WHEREAS, the inoperability of this truck causes a real and immediate emergency in removing ice and snow from the municipal streets; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service informally obtained bids for a used truck with a snow plow and insert from various vendors, as indicated in his memo dated December 7, 2017 attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, four bids were obtained, Robertson Truck Sales Inc., a 2007 International 9200 Dump Truck for \$37,000.00, Robertson Truck Sales Inc., a 2006 International Work Star 7400 Dump Truck for \$39,800.00, National Truck and Equipment Sales, a 2006 International Durastar 4300 Dump Truck for \$34,900.00 and Try Automotive Sales Corporation, a 2005 International Dump Truck with a plow for \$30,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has determined that the Try Auto Sales Corporation 2005 International Dump Truck with a plow is the lowest and best bidder; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service is satisfied that this truck will meet the needs of the Department of Public Service in order to alleviate the emergency; and,

WHEREAS, this Council is obviating any formal bidding process by the authority granted to it in Article V Section 6 of the Parma Heights Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to accept the bid of Try Auto Sales Corporation in the amount of \$30,000.00, as per Exhibit B, to purchase a 2005 International Dump Truck, Serial Number 1HYMKAAR45H699871.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized into a sales agreement with Try Auto Sales Corporation to purchase a 2000 International Dump Truck with plow.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of this municipality and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to replace the truck in the Department of Public Service to remove ice and snow from municipal streets; wherefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by council and approval by the Mayor.
