

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 2020 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR VEHICLES READY FOR PATROL FROM STATEWIDE FORD INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has listed Statewide Ford Inc. as an approved vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has the 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Vehicle Ready for Patrol listed in the state bid price; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase a total of two vehicles for the police department; and

WHEREAS, two 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Vehicles Ready for Patrol are available from Statewide Ford Inc. at state bid pricing for a cost of \$41,599.00 each [Ex. A]; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need to purchase and install in the above described police vehicles additional equipment, in the aggregate amount of \$26,744.00 from Statewide Ford Inc. [Ex. B]; and

WHEREAS, no bidding is required because the aforesaid vehicles are being purchased at the state bid price from a vendor listed on the State Bid; and

WHEREAS, the financing of these vehicles and associated equipment described in Exhibits A and B was approved by this Council in Ordinance 2019 – 25; and

WHEREAS, this Council is also obviating the formal competitive bidding process for the purchase of aforesaid police vehicles and equipment package by the authority granted to it in Article V Section 6 of the Charter, and Sections 145.08 and 145.09 of the Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service has been authorized to purchase two (2) 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Vehicle Ready for Patrol with installation of various equipment from Statewide Ford Inc. for a total of \$41,599.00; for the aggregate amount of \$83,198.00.

Section 2. The Director of Public Service is also authorized to purchase and install in the above described vehicles additional equipment, in the aggregate amount of \$26,744 from Statewide Ford Inc. as identified as Exhibit B attached hereto; and

Section 3. The financing of the two (2) 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Vehicles Ready for Patrol, with additional equipment for a total aggregate amount of \$109,942.00 was authorized by this Council in Ordinance 2019 – 25.

Section 4. The Mayor is authorized to execute on behalf of the Municipality a purchase agreement with Statewide Ford, Inc., as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 6. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary to obtain two (2) police vehicles for the Police Department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
