

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PURCHASE A 4 TON FALCON ASPHALT RECYCLER/HOT BOX TRAILER FROM THE MCLEAN COMPANY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has listed The McLean Company as an approved vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has the 4 Ton Falcon Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box Trailer listed in the state bid price; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to purchase an Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box; and

WHEREAS, a 4 Ton Falcon Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box Trailer is available from The McLean Company at state bid pricing for a cost of \$21,912.00 [Ex. A]; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need to purchase and install in the Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box additional equipment, at a cost not to exceed \$11,322.00 from The McLean Company [Ex. A]; and

WHEREAS, no bidding is required because the 4 Ton Falcon Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box Trailer with Options is being purchased at the state bid price from a vendor listed on the State Bid; and

WHEREAS, the financing of this equipment was approved by this Council in Ordinance 2019 – 25; and

WHEREAS, this Council is also obviating the formal competitive bidding process for the purchase of aforesaid police vehicles and equipment package by the authority granted to it in Article V Section 6 of the Charter, and Sections 145.08 and 145.09 of the Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service has been authorized to purchase a 4 Ton Falcon Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box Trailer with Options from The McLean Company at a not to exceed cost of \$21,912.00, as identified as Exhibit A, attached hereto.

Section 2. The Director of Public Service is also authorized to purchase and install in the above described Asphalt Recycler additional equipment, in the amount of \$11,322.00 from The McLean Company as identified as Exhibit A, attached hereto.

Section 3. The financing of a 4 Ton Falcon Asphalt Recycler/Hot Box Trailer with Options at a cost of \$33,234.00 was authorized by this Council in Ordinance 2019 – 25.

Section 4. The Mayor is authorized to execute on behalf of the Municipality a purchase agreement with The McLean Company as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 6. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary to purchase this equipment to maintain city streets; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
