

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS, OHIO
Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities
(Section 5310) Grant Program

The City of Parma Heights, which is a public body, intends to submit a Proposal for a capital grant under the provision of 49 USC Section 5310 of the Federal Transit Act to provide transportation services for the elderly and disabled within the City of Parma Heights, and surrounding areas of Cuyahoga County. The grant Proposal will request a 12 passenger/2 wheelchair light transit, wide body senior transport vehicle.

It is projected that 24 persons will use the service five (5) times a week for various activities, including transportation to local senior centers, area hospitals, retail/grocery stores, medical offices and leisure activities.

The City of Parma Heights invites comments and proposals from all interested public, private and paratransit operators including taxi operators for the provision of transportation service to the elderly and disabled within our service area.

Operators who are interested in offering proposals to provide service should contact Joseph E. The public meeting will be held on January 25, 2018, at 12:00 noon in the lunch room located at the Parma Heights Senior Center, Educator Apartments, 9275 North Church Drive, Parma Heights, Ohio 44130. The Senior Center is a handicapped accessible location.

Upon request to the City, the City shall make reasonable accommodation for a disabled person to be able to participate in this meeting.
