The City of Parma Heights has designed a soccer program for the youth of our community. This fall, we will once again be offering a soccer program for boys and girls born in the year 2009 to born in the year 2002. There is a Munchkin Program for kids born in the year 2012 to born in the year 2010. Our main objectives are for the boys and girls to have **FUN** while learning to play a team sport, and to learn the basic skills and rules of soccer.

The soccer league is open to all boys and girls. Registration for the 2016-17 season will be Thursday, June 30th and Tuesday, July 5th from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Parma Hts. City Hall. The registration fee is \$55.00 per child for residents and \$65.00 for non-residents. Munchkins will be \$35.00 for residents and \$45.00 for non-residents. A \$10 late fee will apply after these dates.

Girls--Our program has grown to the point that we have all girl teams playing against all girl teams born in the year 2009 to born in the year 2002. All girls are asked to sign up now.

The first half of the 2016-2017 season will start with practice in mid-August and games starting September 10, 2016 with games over by the end of October. The second half will start with practice in mid-March and games starting April 8, 2017. The season will be over the end of May. The spring season includes team pictures and participation in the Parma Hts. Memorial Day Parade.
