

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-4

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS OR HIS DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR FUNDING FOR OLDER AMERICANS ACT TITLE III FUNDING THROUGH THE WESTERN RESERVE AREA AGENCY ON AGING "WRAAA", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, The Western Reserve Area Agency on Aging ("WRAAA") is soliciting proposals from municipalities that provide Older Americans Act Title III funding for older adults; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding of these programs will fill a gap in senior services by assisting older citizens in their efforts to live and function independently.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Parma Heights, or his designee, is authorized and directed to submit a grant application and enter into a contract for Older Americans Act Title III Funding through "WRAAA".

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason that it is necessary to submit an application and enter into a contract for funding for Older Americans Act Title III funding through the Western Reserve Area Agency on Aging "WRAAA"; wherefore, this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
