

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA DIVISION OF SENIOR AND ADULT SERVICES ("DSAS") TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights submitted Options for Independent Living Transportation Services RFP #360640 on January 19, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the funding provided by Options for Independent Living Transportation Services will help in assisting older and disabled citizens in their efforts to live and function independently, and

WHEREAS, the City has demonstrated the necessary expertise, knowledge, and resources to successfully furnish such services to "DSAS"; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to enter into a contract for transportation services with the Cuyahoga County Division of Senior and Adult Services ("DSAS") for a term starting April 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2017.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Parma Heights is authorized to enter into a contract for transportation services with the Cuyahoga County Division of Senior and Adult Services ("DSAS").

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into a transportation services contract for additional funding to assist older and disabled citizens in their efforts to live and function independently; wherefore, this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
