

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-16

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PERMANENT, NONEXCLUSIVE EASEMENT IN, ON, OVER, ACROSS, UNDER AND THROUGH A CERTAIN REAL PREMISES LOCATED WITHIN THE CLEVELAND METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY IN THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, MODIFYING, SUPPLEMENTING, MAINTAINING, OPERATING AND/OR REMOVING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND SUPPORTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. This Council does accept the easement for constructing, reconstructing, modifying, supplementing, maintaining, operating and/or removing traffic control devices and supports for certain real premises located within the Cleveland Metropolitan Park District property in the City, in the form of Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten herein.

Section 2. This easement is necessary for the City of Parma to install new traffic control signal and equipment at Snow Road and Big Creek Parkway and at Hauserman Road and Snow Road. This Council recognizes that all costs associated with the installation and ongoing maintenance and repair of these signals will be the sole responsibility of the City of Parma.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of this municipality and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into an easement for the improvements of certain traffic control devices located in the municipality; wherefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
