

RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 7

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR WIRELESS LEASE BUYOUT AT MUNICIPAL OWNED PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE GREENBRIAR MONOPOLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights owns the Greenbriar Monopole located in the Greenbriar Commons at 6200 Pearl Road; and,

WHEREAS, wireless providers are co-located on the monopole and lease locations on the monopole; and,

WHEREAS, the city is desirous of exploring the possibility of a wireless lease buyout for the co-locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council authorizes and directs the Director of Public Service to prepare bid specifications and advertise for proposals of a wireless lease buyout for co-locations on the Greenbriar Monopole once a week for five consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Council declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of this municipality; and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary so that such bid specifications and advertisement for the wireless lease buyout can be prepared; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
