

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 15**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE POLICE DEPARTMENTS OF PARMA, PARMA HEIGHTS, BROOKLYN, BROOK PARK AND SEVEN HILLS FOR SHARED CRASH INVESTIGATION SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Police Departments of Parma, Parma Heights, Brooklyn and Seven Hills for Shared Crash Investigation Services in the form of Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully rewritten.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason that shared crash investigation services will benefit our police department; wherefore it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
