

RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY FOR FUNDING FOR THE 2020 TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights is submitting an application to the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) for funding through the 2020 Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) Implementation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 TLCI Implementation Grant program provides federal funds for projects that integrate transportation and land use planning, increase transportation options, promote livability, and advance the goals of the NOACA Strategic Plan for Northeast Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 TLCI Implementation Grant program applicants are eligible to receive 100% federal funding with awards covering the entire project cost and no local match is required; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 TLCI Implementation Grant program is paid on a reimbursement basis, requiring the applicant to first expend funds and then request reimbursement from NOACA; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights agrees to be responsible for managing any and all sub-contracting agencies, organizations, or consultants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights agrees to complete the agreed upon scope of services or will forfeit current and future TLCI awards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights is authorized to execute a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and NOACA if selected for the TLCI Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to submit this application to NOACA, acting as designated recipient of ODOT funds, for the TLCI Program.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute a contract with NOACA if awarded a TLCI grant, as approved by the Department of Law.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to execute a contract with ODOT, as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of this municipality and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the submission of the application for funding; wherefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
