

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO NOTIFY THE CENTRAL COLLECTION AGENCY [CCA] THAT THE CITY DESIRES TO TERMINATE THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS AND CCA EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Heights and the Central Collection Agency entered into an agreement for the administration and collection of taxes on or about January 8, 2018, as authorized by Ordinance 2018 – 1; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Director of Finance recommend that the city withdraw from this agreement effective December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the agreement between the City and CCA requires that any withdrawal from CCA shall be effective only on December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year of withdrawal and shall be preceded by written notice of withdrawal lawfully authorized by the legislative body.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of Finance recommend to this Council that the Agreement between the City of Parma Heights and CCA be terminated effective December 31, 2020.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of Finance are authorized to provide written notice to CCA that the City is terminating the agreement with CCA effective on December 31, 2020. The written notice is to be received by the Administrator of the Central Collection Agency not later than July 1, 2020, which is set forth in Exhibit A.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason that the city will terminate the agreement with CCA effective December 31, 2020; wherefore it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
