

ORDINANCE NO. 1965-29

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A MASTER STREET TREE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS, AND REGULATING THE REMOVAL, PLANTING, AND MAINTENANCE OF TREES IN PUBLIC AREAS, AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID REGULATIONS

Section 1. There is hereby adopted for the City of Parma Heights a Master Street Tree Planning document showing varieties of trees to be planted in the public right of way of all streets within the city, said plan is contained under separate cover attached to this ordinance, and incorporated in this ordinance by reference as if fully set forth herein. No person shall hereafter plant, transplant or move any public tree on or to any street of the city except to a location where it will be in conformation to the Master Street Tree Plan and the species or varieties therein designated.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership or corporation to plant, remove, or destroy any tree on the public right of way of any street in the City of Parma Heights, which is not in conformity with the Master Street Tree Plan.

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$200.

Section 4. WHEREFORE this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after the earliest period provided by law.
