

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2022 DEMERS MXP 170 TYPE 1 AMBULANCE FROM PENN CARE, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has listed Penn Care, Inc. as a vendor; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the State Cooperative Purchasing Program, ID Number 800790; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services for the State of Ohio has a 2022 Demers MXP 170 Type 1 Ambulance listed in the state bid price; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has received a proposal from Penn Care, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of 2022 Demers MXP 170 Type 1 Ambulance for the Fire Department, from Penn Care Inc., through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program, ID Number 800790, in an amount not to exceed \$206,731.00 as set forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has reviewed the specifications, as set forth in Exhibit B and recommends that Council authorize the purchase and delivery of a 2022 Demers MXP 170 Type 1 Ambulance for the Fire Department from Penn Care, Inc., through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program ID Number 800790, in an amount not to exceed \$206,731.00, as set forth in the Purchase Agreement dated June 8 2021, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for an ambulance for the Fire Department to service the residents of Parma Heights; and

WHEREAS, no bidding is required since the ambulance is being purchased at the state bid price; and,

WHEREAS, this Council is also obviating the formal competitive bidding process for the purchase of the aforesaid ambulance by the authority granted to it in Article V Section 6 of the Charter, and Sections 145.08 and 145.09 of the Codified Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to purchase from Penn Care Inc., one (1) 2022 Demers MXP 170 Type 1 Ambulance, through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program, ID Number 800790, in an amount not to exceed \$206,731.00, as set forth in the Purchase Agreement dated June 8 2021, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the Mayor is authorized and empowered to execute the Purchase Agreement on behalf of the City of Parma Heights.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and for the further reason it is necessary to obtain an emergency vehicle for the safety of the residents; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
