

ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL AND ASPHALT CONTRACTOR SERVICES, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS, FOR VARIOUS ROAD REPAIR AND REHABILITATION PROJECTS, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has reviewed the condition of various streets, including, but not limited to, Amrap Drive, Kings Highway, Calamie Drive, Doxmere Drive, Westborough Drive, and Stoneham Road, and recommends that this Council authorize expenditures and competitive bidding necessary for such public improvement, in an amount estimated not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

WHEREAS, due to the nature said public improvements and the estimated amount of the expenditure, the Director of Public Service seeks the authorization and direction of this Council, in accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of Article V Section 6 of the Charter of the City of Parma Heights, to publicly and competitively bid said road improvement projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1: This Council does hereby authorize the expenditure of monies of this municipality for public improvement projects, including Amrap Drive, Kings Highway, Calamie Drive, Doxmere Drive, Westborough Drive, and Stoneham Road, as described in the title, which expenditure is now estimated not to exceed \$500,000.00, is authorized and directed. The expenditure shall be made from monies appropriated by this Council for such public road improvement purpose.

Section 2: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for and publicize such competitive bids for an agreement to perform road repair and rehabilitation asphalt construction services, as a prerequisite to such expenditures, at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the Municipality and to post such Invitation to Bid on the City of Parma Heights official web page.

Section 3: The Mayor is further authorized and directed to enter into a written contract with the lowest and best bidder after such advertising, said lowest and best bidder to be determined by motion of this Council.

Section 4: This Council declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of this municipality and for the further reason that it is necessary to authorize and direct such expenditure in order that the Public Service Director may immediately commence public bidding requirements in accordance with applicable laws and so that agreements to perform such public improvement projects may be

commenced seasonally; wherefore, it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval of the Mayor.
