Empty and flatten.



CARTONS
Empty and rinse. Discard cap. Flatten.



CUPS (PAPER & PLASTIC)
Empty and rinse. No straws. Discard lids.



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS
Empty and rinse.



PAPER & BOXES
Empty and flatten boxes.



PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS & TUBS
Empty and rinse. Attach lid.
