#### Resolution Passes

Mayor Gallo asked to make a statement on the records from Safety Director Scharschmidt and it read as follows: In my 34 years working for the city, I have never been witness to anything as serious and devastating as this week's storm. Seeing the departments work together for the betterment of our residents and business owners was refreshing when we see so much bad in the news. Police had extra officers on patrol and made sure residents saw them when the sun went down and there was no power. They assisted in filling generators while service was busy or on the minimal breaks. They did multiple welfare checks on residents who were without power and had family concerned. Fire was running on over 143 calls related to this storm. They worked through residents needing oxygen, coordinated with the county for assistance to residents and had two full residential fires in the middle of all of the chaos. They never missed a beat. Both Chiefs wanted council to know that Sgt. Greene and Assistant Chief Clark were absolutely invaluable throughout the last week. They worked tirelessly and truly stepped up to assist both Chiefs and the city.
