

RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS COUNTY ROAD 50/50 PROGRAM FUNDING APPLICATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works has made the City of Parma Heights aware of the opportunity to participate in County Road 50/50 Program Funding for 2027 and 2028 in order to maintain and improve designated roads; and

WHEREAS, the City, upon application, may qualify for funding of up to 50% of the road construction costs up to a maximum amount of \$250,000.00 should the project be favorably considered; and

WHEREAS, the City made a timely application for consideration of the Ridgewood Road Rehab Project to the County and awaits further direction, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to authorize and support the City of Parma Heights's application for said county road improvement funding and to authorize further application measures for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council of the City of Parma Heights hereby authorizes and supports the City of Parma Heights County Road 50/50 Program Funding application for 2027 and 2028 to the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works for the Ridgewood Road Rehab Project.

Section 2: That this Council hereby respectfully requests that the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works give favorable consideration to the City of Parma Heights County Road 50/50 Program Funding application for funding for the Ridgewood Road Rehab Project.

Section 3: That Council hereby authorizes further application measures to seek favorable consideration for the City's application for Ridgewood Road Rehab Project for the County Road 50/50 Program Funding.

Section 4: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees comprised of a majority of the members of the Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of said City and for further reason that this measure is necessary to seek favorable consideration and to further application measures in a timely manner for the County Road 50/50 Program Funding; wherefore, this Resolution shall

be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
